# WHERE CAN I FIND THAT? WHERE CAN MY COMMITTEE MEET?

MEETING SPACES Before scheduling a meeting, check the SGC web site calendar for potential conflicts. Do not make plans to use a meeting space before contacting our SGC Meeting Arrangement Chair; a fee may apply. Arrangements must be made in advance through our Meeting Arrangements Chair (this process in place as of January 2016):

- Isaacson Hall SGC Office (suitable for up to six people)
- Isaacson Hall Meeting Rooms: Boardroom (suitable for 12+);
   Classroom (larger, suitable for 20+)
- NHS Hall where our regular Hort and General Meetings take place large groups
- Graham Visitor Center, at Arboretum (small and large rooms available)

The Atrium area of CUH is usable if available. Reservations are not required, but the Atrium is used often by others and for some regularly scheduled CUH activities so should never be counted on.

Seattle Garden Club has three separate storage areas on CUH grounds. All required keys kept in SGC file in the mail room of Merrill Hall.

- The CUH/SGC office on the main floor of Isaacson Hall, Room 104
- The closet in the basement below the Isaacson office, Room 012
- The storage shed at the southeast corner of the CUH grounds (accessible by car or by foot)

**SGC OFFICE**, Isaacson Hall, Room 104

Refreshment table supplies are stored here and used for regular Hort and General meetings. This space may be used for committee meetings of up

to six people (see schedule information in this report). The desk is shared with CUH staff on a very regular basis so the meeting space is not dependable. It is not unusual to find that CUH has put some temporary things in the room when their need arises.

SGC Contents: Archives, stationery, Yearbooks, small awards, recent files, meeting supplies (tablecloths, napkins, cups, etc...). See inventory list below. A handwritten list also exists in the top, left drawer of the file cabinet, last updated 6/2015. The drawer is labelled *Standing Committees*.

## **BASEMENT CLOSET**, Isaacson Hall, Room 012

Contents: Vases, past flower show reports and supplies, President's file boxes, SGC projector, portable microphone and Speaker System with sign-out board, portable standing screen. <u>Inventory included as of 1/2016</u>.

**STORAGE SHED**, located at East side of CUH parking lot, accessible by car or foot; requires unlocking gate, as well (ground lock most easily lifted if using both hands and lifting from bottom)
